**Speaker: Mr. Steve O'Neill - President of Boeing Satellite Systems International, Inc. (BSSI)**

Who is the President of Boeing Satellite Systems International, Inc. (BSSI), a wholly owned subsidiary of The Boeing Company in El Segundo, Calif. Mr. O'Neill is responsible for general management of the world's largest manufacturer of commercial and civil communications satellites. He also has oversight for a variety of programs including DIRECTTV, GOES, Mobile Satellite Ventures, Protostar, Spaceway, TDRS and Thuraya.

In the past year there have been a number of interesting developments within both the satellite and communication industries. From the number of large and small satellite broadband consolidations and mergers within the providers for Fixed Satellite Services (FSS), to how Satellite pay-TV may now be peaking in the terms of subscribers in some regions and markets of the world, to even how US Military and Government Markets are becoming increasingly dependent on the Global Commercial Satellite Communication (SATCOM) services, and how such demand is growing faster than the 'dedicated supply'. Mr. O'Neil will give perspective and overview on the commercial satellite market such as broadband, wideband and mobile satellite capabilities.

Mr. O'Neill has over 30 years experience in the aerospace industry principally involved in satellite and launch vehicle programs. His experience includes engineering, manufacturing, supplier management, business management, business development and program management. He has worked in commercial, Civil, Air Force and classified areas.

Prior to joining The Boeing Company, Mr. O'Neill worked for Lockheed Martin. Mr. O'Neill served in the United States Air Force and piloted B-52 and T-38 aircraft. He earned a B.S. degree in Engineering from the United States Air Force Academy and a MBA degree from the University of Northern Colorado. He is also a graduate of the Defense Acquisition University with a degree as a professional government program manager.
